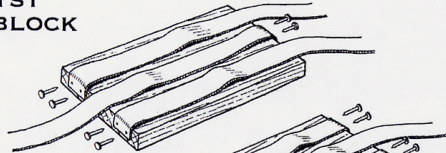
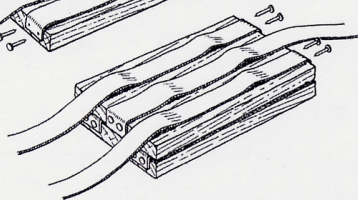


## JACOB'S LADDER

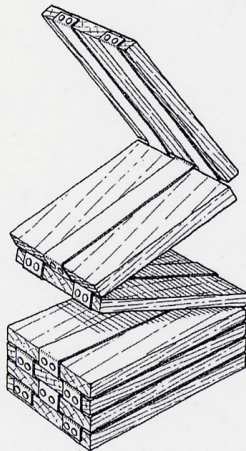
1ST

### Notes:

1. We used a single 7/16" thumb tack in place of the two screws. Also our blocks were 2 5/16 x 3 1/2 x 7/16 inch.
2. Alignment of the ribbons is important so they don't rub on each other too much (leave a little space, keep them parallel).
3. You may want to adjust the play/slack to make it run smoothly. A little slack in each corner is ok.
4. In the essence of time we did not paint the toy but your son can disassemble it and do so.
5. Once you are satisfied with the running it is a GOOD Idea to glue the ribbons under the tacks. (Fabric glue is best) Be CAREFUL not to get glue under the ribbon on the face of the board, only glue under the end)
6. Trim the ribbons for flush look and put a touch of glue on the end fibers to keep it from fraying. (Polyester).
